Shorea (Sal) Butter is obtained from the fruit of the Sal tree (Shorea Robusta) in India. The butter is extracted from its fruit seeds and then further processed and refined to obtain a light colored butter which has a low odor and smooth, dense texture.

Shorea Butter is solid at room temperature, but melts readily upon contact with the skin. It has physical properties similar to cocoa butter, and it exhibits excellent emolliency properties, softening effects and good spreadability on the skin. It is said to prevent drying of the skin and development of wrinkles and reduce degeneration of skin cells while restoring skin flexibility.
